RE: **June 1, 2013 Wage Increase and Fringe Benefit Allocation**
Laborers' Local #238 and #348
Heavy/Highway and Building Construction Labor Agreement

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The bargaining parties have now completed negotiations for the wage package effective June 1, 2013. The new total package increase of \$.70 per hour in both Pasco and Spokane will be allocated with \$.40 per hour to Health & Welfare, \$.01 per hour to LECET and the remainder to wages. The revised wage and fringe benefit rates through May 31, 2014 are as follows:

Washington Fair Contracting	\$.04+
Laborers' Political League++	\$.03

+NOTE: The deduction for Washington Fair Contracting Foundation has been removed from this agreement. You no longer need to withhold the \$.04 per hour from net wages effective June 1, 2012.

++Deduct from net wages only with written authorization from employee.

REMINDER: Under the provisions of Article 22, Public Works Projects, you must make any adjustment on the Health & Welfare contribution even though the wage rates and remaining fringe benefit contributions are frozen for the initial 24 months or duration of the project, whichever is the lesser.
