June 1, 2012 Wage Increase and Fringe Benefit Allocation

Laborers' Local #238 and #348

Heavy/Highway and Building Construction Labor Agreement

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The bargaining parties have now completed a new four (4) year agreement. This agreement provides for a total package increase of \$.70 per hour in both Pasco and Spokane effective June 1, 2012. The total package increase has been allocated with \$.30 per hour to Health & Welfare and the remainder to wages.

This agreement also recognizes the Laborers' new 6000 hour apprenticeship program for apprentices registered after June 1, 2012. These apprentices will be required to complete 6000 hours of on-the-job training before becoming a Journeyman Laborer and have two additional step increases at 85% and 95%. The new 6000 hour increases are listed in bold under the apprenticeship rates on the back of this letter. Apprentices registered prior to June 1, 2012 are grandfathered under the 4000 hour program with increases at 60%, 70%, 80% and 90%.

The revised wage and fringe benefit rates through May 31, 2013 are as follows:

⁺NOTE: The deduction for Washington Fair Contracting Foundation has been removed from this agreement. You no longer need to withhold the \$.04 per hour from net wages effective June 1, 2012.

REMINDER: Under the provisions of Article 22, Public Works Projects, you must make any adjustment on the Health & Welfare contribution even though the wage rates and remaining fringe benefit contributions are frozen for the initial 24 months or duration of the project, whichever is the lesser.
