RE: **2021-2024 - Heavy-Highway-Utility-Building Master Labor Agreement
Laborers' Local #335**

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The bargaining parties of this District Council and the Oregon-Columbia Chapter of the AGC have now completed a new three (3) year agreement. This agreement provides for a total package increase of 4% plus \$0.50 per hour effective June 1, 2021. The total package increase has been allocated with \$.50 per hour to Health & Welfare, \$0.25 per hour to Pension and the remaining to wages. The revised wage and fringe benefit rates through May 31, 2022 are as follows:
